The Potsdam media landscape looks back on a history of almost 100 years. When film pioneer Guido Seeber was looking for adequate premises in the outskirts of Berlin for his film company Deutsche Bioscop GmbH in 1911, he discovered space in the district Neubabelsberg. On 3 November 1911 he laid the foundation for the first film-studio. Just a few months later, on 12 February 1912, the first take of the film "Totentanz" was shot with Asta Nielsen in the lead.

Today, Potsdam-Babelsberg ranks among the most renowned locations of the national and international film and media landscape. Great film productions, popular TV series, and digital media products are created on the 46 hectare area, home of more than 130 companies, employing over 2 000 people.

With the annual theme "Potsdam 2011 – City of Film", the state capital of Brandenburg celebrates its film tradition. Experience a city rich in culture and film tradition, while enjoying film presentations, exhibitions, premiere celebrations, special guided tours, and open air events. We invite you to explore our historical treasures at the world-famous film city Potsdam-Babelsberg!
