Marching Show Band Definitions

Division (Based on achievement record)

Division I: (Championship Division)

Bands who have received a first prize rating at any recognized International Competition, Major Regional Competition or a National Championship may apply for placement in Division I based upon their performance credentials. After review of the band's performance credentials and application resume, placement in either Division I or II will be determined by WAMSB.

Division II: (Competition Division)

This is the standard division of entry for most bands at International Band Competitions.

Division III: (Festival Division)

Bands of any category who are admitted as a participant for Festival ratings will be placed in Division III.

Category (Based on member age)

Open:

Any band that does not qualify for admission to the Senior, Junior or Juvenile band categories will be placed in the Open category.

Senior:

Any band that does not qualify for admission to the Junior or Juvenile band categories will be placed in the Senior category, provided that 95% or more of its performing members are 22 years of age or younger prior to the starting date of the competition.

Junior:

Any band that does not qualify for admission to the Juvenile band category will be placed in the Junior category if 95% or more of its performing members are 16 years of age or younger prior to the starting date of the competition.

Juvenile:

Bands in which the 95% or more of performing members are under 12 years of age prior to the starting of the Championship will be placed in the Juvenile Category. Juvenile bands will be admitted only to the Festival Division.

A Up to a maximum of 60 performing members

AA 60 to a maximum of 100 performing members

AAA 100 to a maximum of 150 performing members

AAAA Over 150 performing members
